Hon'ble Vice President of India Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu visited Malawi from 4-5 November 2018. The Vice President addressed the Indian and diaspora community during Indian community event on 4 November 2018. During the State House visit on 5 November 2018, Hon. Vice President of India met H.E. Prof. Arthur Peter Mutharika, President of the Republic of Malawi. On the occasion of the visit, the two Governments signed three (3) Agreements on Extradition Treaty, Visa Exemption for Holders of Diplomatic and Officials Passports and an MoU on Capacity Building in Regulating the Mining of Radio-Active/Atomic Materials and Rare Earths.

The Vice President also addressed India-Malawi Business Meet on 5 November 2018 where he unveiled the plaques for the Business Incubation Center as well as the India Africa Institute for Agriculture and Rural Development (IAIARD).

Hon'ble Vice President launched the "India for Humanity" initiative with Malawi on 5 November 2018. He handed over two artificial limbs to Malawian beneficiaries & inaugurated one-month workshop set up to fix 500 artificial limbs prepared by the world-renowned Jaipur Foot Technology.
