Collins Magalasi, Chief Economic Advisor and Executive officer to His Excellency Prof. Arthur Peter Mutharika, President of the Republic of Malawi was a Special Invitee of the Ministry of External Affairs, New Delhi from Malawi to attend the Raisina Dialogue held in Delhi from 17-19 January, 2017. The Raisina Dialogue а series is of discussions held amongst prominent World leaders consisting of serving Prime Ministers, Intellectuals, Think Tanks including serving Defence Forces commanders. Raisina Dialogue 2017 was attended by delegates from 65 countries and the inaugural address was by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
